studio ghibli?

Studio Ghibli is an award-winning, world-famous Japanese animation studio.

Created after the success of the film Nausicaä of the Valley of the Wind (1984), directors Isao Takahata and Hayao Miyazaki founded the studio with producer Toshio Suzuki. Studio Ghibli has been involved in various television and media productions, and has created 20+ films over its studio history.

The studio's first film was Castle in the Sky (1986), and most recently released The Boy and the Heron (2023), which won many awards including Best Animated Feature in 2024. Several Studio Ghibli films have been award-winning, or otherwise had a significant impact. The film Spirited Away (2001) was not only multi-award-winning, but also was the top-grossing film in Japan of all time until 2020's Demon Slayer film (by studio Ufotable).

Studio Ghibli is known for their beautiful, meaningful films, spanning multiple time periods and genres. The films range in their target audience and messaging, addressing serious topics such as war and environmental endangerment, alongside light-hearted stories of witches and magical creatures. This semester's zine is dedicated to this studio, which has brought so much joy and insight through its beautiful storytelling and animation.





Kagayaki Masakatsu Takagi

On Kagayaki, Masakatsu Takagi, known for his soundtracks for Mamoru Hosoda's films and a Studio Ghibli documentary, blends spirited chamber folk and ambient elements for an hour and fifteen minutes of pure serenity. Minimalistic piano arrangements are the album's cornerstone, which Takagi builds onto with clusters of woodwinds, strings, and group vocals. In the loudest or quietest moments, you can pick up on field recordings of birds and children's laughter, as if the entire world is celebrating the joyous sound.
