The Honors First Year Seminars, UNIV 1784, (*one required) are one credit first-year experience classes designed specifically for Honors students. They offer incoming students a small class experience and are led by faculty members, known as Faculty Fellows, and co-facilitators, known as Honors facilitators, who are specially trained sophomore Honors students. These courses offer first year students the opportunity to get to know a faculty member and explore an interesting topic very early in their undergraduate careers. It is also an introduction to an Honors education, providing students with a learning environment comprised of critical thinking, problem solving, and in-depth discussions. An important component of the class is the role played by the Honors facilitators, which gives students the opportunity to learn from upper-class Honors peers and successfully transition to campus. Honors facilitators lead the class in team builders, orient students to the programs and services available at UCONN, and answer the typical questions and concerns of first year students.
